PARENTS' TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Thank you for your visit to Pink Tower Children's House (PITCH). We hope you can take time to read our Prospectus and the Parents' Handbook.

Acceptance of your child to Pink Tower Children's House is strictly subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. A pupil will be considered as a candidate for entry to the School when the Registration Form has been completed and returned to us with the non-refundable Registration Fee of ksh 10,000.
2. We do not accept a child until that term's fees has been paid in full.
3. To pay the fees for each term in advance together with all outstanding balances then due to the School not later than the first day of term and, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Head Teacher or Directors, to pay an additional Ksh 4,000 for late payments.
4. That if the fees and all outstanding balances are not paid on or the due date, the School reserves the right to treat the pupil as having been withdrawn from the school without notice in which case you will be liable for the term's fees in lieu of notice of withdrawal.
5. That if you wish to withdraw your child from the School, one term's written notice of withdrawal must be given to the School, or that you have to pay a full term's fees in lieu of notice.
6. That you will be responsible to ensure that all fees and other amounts due are paid.
7. That the School may communicate with any other school which the pupil attends or which a parent proposes the pupil should attend about any matter concerning the pupil or about fees, whether or not the information passing is also held in machine readable form.
8. To recognize the right of the School to remove a child due to parental conduct and behavior.
9. Pink Tower Children's House can support pupils with mild specific learning disabilities, but we are not equipped at this time to provide specific education or the facilities for pupils with moderate or severe learning or physical disabilities.
10. The School does not, unless proved negligent, accept responsibility for accidental injury or loss of property. It is the responsibility of the parents to take out such insurance as they think fit to cover risks such as loss of property, personal injury, liability and medical. The School is not the agent of the parents for any purpose related to insurance.
11. The listed parents/guardians will not be denied access to their children at school unless there is a court order.
